

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2119  
OFFERED BY MR. SCOTT OF VIRGINIA**

Page 16, line 25, strike the semicolon at the end and insert “; and”.

Page 17, line 4, strike the semicolon at the end and insert “; and”.

Page 17, strike lines 5 through 25.

Page 18, line 23, strike the period at the end and insert “; and”.

Page 18, after line 23, insert the following:

- 1           (3) by adding at the end the following:
- 2           “(d) EMERGENCY AUTHORITY.—
- 3           “(1) IN GENERAL.—In response to any emer-
- 4           gency or disaster described in paragraph (3), for the
- 5           duration of the emergency or disaster, the Secretary
- 6           may—
- 7           “(A) modify or broaden the allowable uses
- 8           of funds by grantees and subgrantees solely to
- 9           ensure the continuity of services authorized

1 under this title, including for remote and mobile  
2 service delivery; and

3 “(B) modify or waive any administrative  
4 conditions, processes, or deadlines, including  
5 with respect to—

6 “(i) application requirements;

7 “(ii) reporting requirements; and

8 “(iii) grant award extensions.

9 “(2) CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sub-  
10 section shall be construed to allow altering or  
11 waiving the requirements in section 306(c)(2).

12 “(3) EMERGENCIES DESCRIBED.—The emer-  
13 gencies and disasters described in this paragraph are  
14 the following:

15 “(A) A major disaster declared by the  
16 President under section 401 of the Robert T.  
17 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assist-  
18 ance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170).

19 “(B) An emergency declared by the Presi-  
20 dent under section 501 of the Robert T. Staf-  
21 ford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance  
22 Act (42 U.S.C. 5191).

1                   “(C) A public health emergency deter-  
2                   mined to exist pursuant to section 319 of the  
3                   Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 247d).”.
