SECTION 1. GAO REPORT.

- 2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 18 months after the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States shall submit to the Committee on Education and Labor of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pen-7 sions of the Senate a report on the health care benefits and treatment provided to maritime workers who contract 8 9 COVID-19. 10 (b) Contents.—The report required under sub-11 section (a) shall include—
- 12 (1) an assessment of the delivery of health care 13 under the Longshore and Harbor Workers' Compensation Act (33 U.S.C. 901 et seq.) for maritime 14 15 workers with medical needs due to COVID-19 con-16 tracted in the course of their employment;

1	(2) recommendations necessary to address
2	issues, if any, relating to patient access to care for
3	treatment of COVID-19 under such Act; and
4	(3) an evaluation of claims under such Act re-
5	lating to COVID-19 for maritime workers and sur-
6	vivors that have been approved, denied, or are wait-
7	ing for a final determination, including—
8	(A) the number of such claims reported to
9	the Department of Labor, delineated by certain
10	claim characteristics;
11	(B) the percentage of such claims approved
12	by employers or carriers;
13	(C) an evaluation of the standard that em-
14	ployers and private carriers use to determine
15	causation when such claims are referred, includ-
16	ing information on how employers and private
17	carriers created such a standard and if employ-
18	ers and private carriers are updating the stand-
19	ard to keep up with current scientific standing;
20	(D) the average amount of time it takes
21	for such a claim to be resolved;
22	(E) the number of such claims that are re-
23	ferred to an administrative law judge for resolu-
24	tion; and

1	(F) an evaluation of the standard that the
2	Office of Administrative Law Judges and the
3	Office of Workers' Compensation Programs use
4	to determine causation when such claims are re-
5	ferred, including information on how the De-
6	partment of Labor created such a standard and
7	if the Department is updating the standard to
8	keep up with current scientific standing; and
9	(4) an evaluation of the cost incurred by mari-
10	time employers and their insurance carriers to ad-
11	dress the medical needs of employees who have con-
12	tracted COVID-19 since January 27, 2020.

Add at the end the following:

Amend the title to read as follows: "To direct the Comptroller General to prepare a report on health care benefits and treatment for maritime workers who contract COVID-19, and for other purposes."
