

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 5407
OFFERED BY MS. WILD OF PENNSYLVANIA**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Enhancing Mental
3 Health and Suicide Prevention Through Campus Planning
4 Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. ENCOURAGING CAMPUS COMPREHENSIVE MENTAL**
6 **HEALTH AND SUICIDE PREVENTION PLANS.**

7 Part L of title VIII of the Higher Education Act of
8 1965 (20 U.S.C. 11611 et seq.) is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating section 826 as section 827;
10 and

11 (2) by inserting after section 825 the following
12 new section:

13 **“SEC. 826. ENCOURAGING CAMPUS COMPREHENSIVE MEN-**
14 **TAL HEALTH AND SUICIDE PREVENTION**
15 **PLANS.**

16 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall make efforts
17 to encourage institutions of higher education to develop

1 and implement evidence-based comprehensive campus
2 mental health and suicide prevention plans. Such efforts—

3 “(1) shall be conducted in coordination with the
4 Secretary of Health and Human Services (acting
5 through the Assistant Secretary for Mental Health
6 and Substance Use);

7 “(2) shall align with—

8 “(A) the efforts and approaches rec-
9 ommended by the Suicide Prevention Resource
10 Center;

11 “(B) the programs authorized under sec-
12 tion 9032 of the 21st Century Cures Act (42
13 U.S.C. 290bb–36b note; Public Law 114-255),
14 the amendments made by section 9031 of such
15 Act to section 520E–2 of the Public Health
16 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–36b), and the
17 amendment made by section 9033 of such Act
18 to part D of title V of the Public Health Service
19 Act (42 U.S.C. 290dd et seq.); and

20 “(C) the programs authorized under the
21 Garrett Lee Smith Memorial Act (42 U.S.C.
22 201 note; Public Law 108–355);

23 “(3) shall take into consideration existing Fed-
24 eral and State efforts to address mental health and

1 suicide prevention at institutions of higher edu-
2 cation; and

3 “(4) may be carried out in collaboration with
4 nonprofit organizations, community-based organiza-
5 tions that partner with institutions of higher edu-
6 cation, and other experts and stakeholders in the
7 field of campus mental health and suicide preven-
8 tion.

9 “(b) REPORTS.—The Secretary shall report to the
10 Committee on Education and Labor of the House of Rep-
11 resentatives and the Committee on Health, Education,
12 Labor, and Pensions of the Senate on the efforts of the
13 Secretary carried out under this section—

14 “(1) not later than one year after the date of
15 enactment of the Enhancing Mental Health and Sui-
16 cide Prevention Through Campus Planning Act; and

17 “(2) three years after the date of enactment of
18 such Act.

19 “(c) CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this section shall
20 be construed as creating new statutory requirements for
21 institutions of higher education or granting the Secretary
22 new regulatory authority.”.
