 - b) Have there been any actions to punish the professors who are members of Faculty and Staff for Justice in Palestine who helped promote this event through [social media](#)?

2. [Title 18, Section 2339B of the US Code](#) says it is unlawful to provide material support or resources to designated foreign terrorist organizations.
 - a) Are you certain that university funds are not going to support terrorism?
 - b) Can you say without any doubt that your students are not providing material support to Hamas?
