## A BILL

To require public elementary and middle schools that receive funds under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to obtain parental consent before changing a minor’s gender markers, pronouns, or preferred name on any school form or sex-based accommodations, including locker rooms or bathrooms.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Parental Rights Over  
5        The Education and Care of Their Kids Act” or the “PRO-  
6        TECT Kids Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT RELATED TO GENDER MARKERS,**  
2 **PRONOUNS, AND PREFERRED NAMES ON**  
3 **SCHOOL FORMS.**

4 (a) **REQUIREMENT.**—As a condition of receiving  
5 funds under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act  
6 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 6301 et seq.), a public school that  
7 receives funds under such Act shall be required to obtain  
8 parental consent before changing a covered student’s—

9 (1) gender markers, pronouns, or preferred  
10 name on any school form; or

11 (2) sex-based accommodations, including locker  
12 rooms or bathrooms.

13 (b) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

14 (1) **COVERED STUDENT.**—The term “covered  
15 student” means a minor who is—

16 (A) an elementary school student; or

17 (B) a student in any of the middle grades.

18 (2) **ESEA TERMS.**—The terms “elementary  
19 school”, “middle grades”, and “parent” have the  
20 meanings given such terms in section 8101 of the  
21 Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965  
22 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
