8	(2) meet not less than twice per academic term;

10	(3) serve as a consultative body with respect to
11	institutional policies affecting the health, education,
12	and welfare of student-athletes, including the imple-
13	mentation of this section.
14	(f) Additional Requirements for Individuals
15	SUBJECT TO REGULAR LONG-DISTANCE CONFERENCE
16	TRAVEL.—An institution described in subsection (c) this
17	is a member of a conference that, as a matter of regular

1	scheduling, requires routine travel across more than two
2	time zones for regular season intercollegiate athletic com-
3	petitions, shall, based on recommendations of its student-
4	athlete advisory committee, provide—
5	(1) travel-related academic accommodations, in-
6	cluding excused absences, access to recorded lec-
7	tures, make-up exams, academic tutoring, and re-
8	mote instruction;
9	(2) a stipend of not less than \$1,000 per day
10	for each day of conference-related travel across two
11	or more time zones; and
12	(3) other measures to address academic and
13	health-related impacts of long-distance travel.
14	(g) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in sub-
15	section (f) shall be construed to apply to—
16	(1) nonconference regular season competitions
17	scheduled independently by the institution; or
18	(2) postseason tournaments, playoffs, or cham-
19	pionships governed by the conference or an inter-
20	collegiate athletic association or recognized national
21	governing body.
