

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE  
OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 8210  
OFFERED BY MS. BONAMICI**

Page 1, line 7, strike the item relating to section 502 in the table of contents and insert the following:

Sec. 502. Prohibitions.  
Sec. 503. Effective dates; transition authority.

Redesignate section 502 as section 503, and insert after section 501 the following:

**1 SEC. 502. PROHIBITIONS.**

2 (a) PROHIBITION AGAINST USING ECONOMY ACT  
3 AUTHORITY TO TRANSFER ACTIVITIES.—Notwith-  
4 standing section 1535 of title 31, United States Code  
5 (commonly known as the “Economy Act”), the Secretary  
6 of Education shall not use the authority described in such  
7 section to place an order with another Federal agency for  
8 goods or services described in the amendments made by  
9 this Act, or related to authorities, functions, or services  
10 described in the amendments made by this Act.

11 (b) PROHIBITION ON INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS.—  
12 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Depart-  
13 ment of Education shall not enter into any form of agree-  
14 ment with another Federal agency to exercise any author-

1 ity, carry out any function, or provide any service author-  
2 ized under the amendments made by this Act.

3 (c) PROHIBITION ON AGREEMENTS AND TRANSFER  
4 OF FUNDS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
5 the Secretary of Education shall not make, enter into, or  
6 perform an agreement with any other Federal agency to  
7 exercise the authorities, carry out the functions, or provide  
8 the services authorized in the amendments made by this  
9 Act.

10 (d) INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS SHALL HAVE NO  
11 FORCE OR EFFECT.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Interagency agreements  
13 listed in paragraph (2), any addenda to any such  
14 agreements, or any similar successor agreements,  
15 shall have no force or effect with respect to the  
16 amendments made by this Act.

17 (2) INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS.—The Inter-  
18 agency agreements listed in this paragraph are as  
19 follows:

20 (A) The Interagency Agreement Between  
21 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
22 Department of Labor entered into on May 21,  
23 2025 (relating to workforce development part-  
24 nership).

1 (B) The Interagency Agreement Between  
2 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
3 Department of Labor Relating to the Office of  
4 Elementary and Secondary Education (OESE)  
5 entered into on September 30, 2025.

6 (C) The Interagency Agreement Between  
7 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
8 Department of Labor Relating to Higher Edu-  
9 cation Programs entered into on September 30,  
10 2025.

11 (D) The Interagency Agreement Between  
12 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
13 Department of the Interior Relating to the Of-  
14 fice of Indian Education entered into on Sep-  
15 tember 30, 2025.

16 (E) The Interagency Agreement Between  
17 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
18 Department of Health and Human Services Re-  
19 lating to the National Committee on Foreign  
20 Medical Education and Accreditation  
21 (NCFMEA) entered into on September 30,  
22 2025.

23 (F) The Interagency Agreement Between  
24 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
25 Department of Health and Human Services,

1 Administration for Children and Families Re-  
2 relating to the CCAMPIS Program entered into  
3 on September 30, 2025.

4 (G) The Interagency Agreement Between  
5 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
6 Department of State Relating to International  
7 and Foreign Language Education (IFLE) en-  
8 tered into on September 30, 2025.

9 (H) The Interagency Agreement Between  
10 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
11 Department of State entered into on February  
12 20, 2026 (relating to section 117 partnership).

13 (I) The Interagency Agreement Between  
14 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
15 Department of Health and Human Services Re-  
16 lating to Family Engagement and School Sup-  
17 port entered into on February 20, 2026.

18 (J) The Interagency Agreement Between  
19 the U.S. Department of Education and U.S.  
20 Department of the Treasury entered into on  
21 March 19, 2026 (relating to the procurement of  
22 services for the Federal student assistance pro-  
23 grams).
