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Friedberg's articles and essays have appeared in a number of publications, including *The Wall Street Journal*, *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *Commentary*, *The National Interest*, *The American Interest*, *The Weekly Standard*, *Foreign Affairs*, *The Washington Quarterly*, *Survival*, and *International Security*. In 2001-2002 Friedberg was selected as the first occupant of the Henry A. Kissinger Chair at the Library of Congress. He has been a research fellow at the Australian Strategic Policy Institute, the Norwegian Nobel Institute, the Smithsonian Institution's Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars, and Harvard University's Center for International Affairs. Dr. Friedberg served from June 2003 to June 2005 as Deputy Assistant for National Security Affairs in the office of the Vice President. After leaving government he was appointed to the Defense Policy Board and the Secretary of State's Advisory Committee on Democracy Promotion. Friedberg received his AB in 1978 and his PhD in 1986, both from Harvard University. He is a member of the editorial boards of *Joint Forces Quarterly* and *The Journal of Strategic Studies* and a member of the International Institute for Strategic Studies and the Council on Foreign Relations.
