

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7682
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. 17. LIMITATION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds authorized to
3 be appropriated by this Act may be made available for
4 Sudan until the Secretary of State determines that Sudan
5 is no longer a state sponsor of terrorism.

6 (b) STATE SPONSOR OF TERRORISM DEFINED.—In
7 this section, the term “state sponsor of terrorism” means
8 a country, the government of which the Secretary of State
9 has determined, for purposes of section 1754(c)(1)(A)(i)
10 of the Export Control Reform Act of 2018 (50 U.S.C.
11 4813(c)(1)(A)(i)), section 620A of the Foreign Assistance
12 Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2371), section 40 of the Arms
13 Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2780), or any other provi-
14 sion of law, is a government that has repeatedly provided
15 support for acts of international terrorism.
