## A BILL

To amend the Arms Export Control Act to modify certain provisions relating to AUKUS defense trade cooperation, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3	SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS RE-
4	LATING TO AUKUS DEFENSE TRADE CO-
5	OPERATION.
6	Section 38 of the Arms Export Control Act (22
7	U.S.C. 2778) is amended—
8	(1) in subsection (j)(1)(C)(ii)—
9	(A) by striking subclauses (I), (II), and
10	(III); and

(B) redesignating subclauses (IV), (V), 1 2 (VI), and (VII) as subclauses (I), (II), (III), 3 and (IV), respectively; and 4 (2) in subsection (1)(4)— (A) in subparagraph (B), by striking "sub-5 6 section (j)(1)(C)(ii)" and inserting "any of sub-(IV) 7 clauses (I) through of subsection (i)(1)(C)(ii)"; and 8 9 (B) in subparagraph (C)(ii), by adding at 10 the end before the period the following: "and 11 does not relate to the Missile Technology Con-12 trol Regime". 13 SEC. 2. STATEMENT OF POLICY. 14 (a) IN GENERAL.—It shall no longer be the policy of the United States to apply a "presumption of denial" 15 to exports of materials considered Category 1 or 2 of the Missile Technology Control Regime to North Atlantic 17 Treaty Organization (NATO) allies, major non-NATO allies, or the other countries of the "Five Eyes" intelligence 20 alliance. 21 (b) FIVE Eyes Intelligence ALLIANCE DE-FINED.—In this section, the term "Five Eyes' intelligence alliance" means Australia, Canada, New Zealand, 24 the United Kingdom, and the United States.
