Mauricio Claver-Carone is the Executive Director of Cuba Democracy Advocates in Washington, D.C., a non-partisan organization dedicated to the promotion of human rights, democracy and the rule of law in Cuba.

Mauricio has served as an Attorney-Advisor for the U.S. Department of the Treasury. Prior to his work in government, he served as a Clinical Assistant Professor at The Catholic University of America's School of Law and as an Adjunct Professor at The George Washington University's National Law Center.

A prodigious writer, his work has been featured in a variety of publications including: *The New York Times*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Politico*, *The Hill*, *Georgetown Journal of International Law* and *Yale Journal of International Affairs*.

Mauricio is also the Editor of the well-known website, *Capitol Hill Cubans*, and host of the foreign policy show "*From Washington Al Mundo*" on Sirius-XM's Cristina Radio.
