Dr. Thomas Melito is a director in the International Affairs and Trade Team at GAO. In this capacity, he is primarily responsible for GAO's work involving international sanctions, and nonproliferation. Under Dr. Melito's leadership, GAO has produced a series of reports examining the implementation of sanctions on Iran, including their impact on the Iranian economy as well as the U.S. government's use of waivers and exceptions related to the export of Iranian petroleum products. In addition, GAO recently completed a review of the implementation of U.S. and U.N. sanctions on North Korea. Furthermore, GAO also recently examined State's process for informing Congress on Russian compliance with the Intermediate Nuclear Forces Treaty.

Dr. Melito holds an MA and PhD in economics from Columbia University and a BS in industrial and labor relations from Cornell University.
