

Zack Cooper is a research fellow at the American Enterprise Institute, where he studies U.S. defense strategy and alliances in Asia, as well as U.S.-China strategic competition. He is also an adjunct assistant professor at Georgetown University, an associate with Armitage International, and a National Asia Research Fellow.
