

Jeff Abramson is a non-resident senior fellow for arms control and conventional arms transfers at the Arms Control Association. He also manages and founded the Forum on the Arms Trade, a professional network of more than 75 national and international experts who work to strengthen public efforts to address the humanitarian, economic and other implications of arms transfers, security assistance, and weapons use. Earlier this decade, he served as a policy advisor and director to the secretariat of Control Arms, the global civil society alliance that championed the adoption of the Arms Trade Treaty that for the first time established global regulations for the trade in a wide array of conventional weapons. He is also the former deputy director of the Arms Control Association and former managing editor of their publication *Arms Control Today*.

Abramson holds a Master of Public Policy from the Goldman School of Public Policy at the University of California, Berkeley, and an undergraduate degree from Princeton University.
