3 **SECTION 1. OFFICER JAMES BONNEAU MEMORIAL POST**
4 **OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 113 West Michigan Avenue in

1 Jackson, Michigan, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Officer James Bonneau Memorial Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Officer James
7 Bonneau Memorial Post Office”.
