3 **SECTION 1. CHIEF JOSEPH E. WHITE, JR. POST OFFICE**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 113 West Jackson Street in Rich

1 Square, North Carolina, shall be known and designated
2 as the “Chief Joseph E. White, Jr. Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Chief Joseph E.
7 White, Jr. Post Office Building”.

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
