3 SEC. 80001. GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION CLEAN

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VEHICLE FLEET.

5 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is appropriated to the General Services Administration for 6 fiscal year 2022, out of any money in the Treasury not 7 8 otherwise appropriated, \$5,000,000,000, to remain avail-9 able until expended, for the procurement of electric vehicles and related infrastructure for the Federal fleet, (ex-10 cluding any vehicles of the United States Postal Service 11 and including non-tactical vehicles of the Department of 12 13 Defense) and the management, acquisition, and allocation of such electric vehicles and infrastructure and working 14 15 with Federal agencies to allocate and lease resources as 16 necessary.

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1SEC. 80002. GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION OFFICE2OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL CLEAN VEHI-3CLE FLEET OVERSIGHT.

4 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is 5 appropriated to the Office of the Inspector General of the General Services Administration for fiscal year 2022, out 6 7 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, 8 \$2,500,000, to remain available until expended, for over-9 sight of the procurement of electric vehicles and related infrastructure for the Federal fleet at the General Services 10 11 Administration.

12 SEC. 80003. UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE; CLEAN VEHI-

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CLE FLEET AND FACILITY MAINTENANCE.

14 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is appropriated to the United States Postal Service for fiscal 15 year 2022, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise 16 17 appropriated, \$2,400,000,000, to remain available until September 30, 2031, to be deposited into the Postal Serv-18 19 ice Fund established under section 2003 of title 39, 20United States Code, to acquire electric vehicles for the 21 Postal Service fleet, of which \$1,200,000,000 shall be for 22 the purchase of electric delivery vehicles and 23 \$1,200,000,000 shall be for the purchase of the related 24 infrastructure to support such vehicles.

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1SEC. 80004. UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE OFFICE OF2THE INSPECTOR GENERAL CLEAN VEHICLE3FLEET PROCUREMENT OVERSIGHT.

4 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is 5 appropriated to the Office of the Inspector General of the United States Postal Service for fiscal year 2022, out of 6 7 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, 8 \$8,200,000, to remain available until September 30, 2031, 9 to be deposited into the Postal Service Fund established under section 2003 of title 39, United States Code, to per-10 11 form oversight of the United States Postal Service's acquisition and deployment of electric vehicles and such infra-12 13 structure as may be required to support such vehicles.

14 SEC. 80005. NATIONAL ARCHIVES AND RECORDS ADMINIS-

TRATION.

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16 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is appropriated to the National Archives and Records Ad-17 ministration for fiscal year 2022, out of any money in the 18 19 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$50,000,000 to re-20main available until expended to address backlogs in re-21 sponding to requests from veterans for military personnel 22 records, improve cyber security, improve digital preserva-23 tion and access to archival Federal records, and address 24 backlogs in requests made under section 552 of title 5, United States Code (commonly referred to as the Freedom 25

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of Information Act). Such amounts may also be used for
 the Federal Records Center Program.

3 SEC. 80006. FUNDING FOR GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY 4 OFFICE.

5 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is appropriated for fiscal year 2022, out of any money in 6 7 the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$25,000,000, to 8 remain available until expended, for the Comptroller Gen-9 eral to conduct oversight of the receipt, disbursement, and use of funds and exercise of authorities provided by this 10 Act, including oversight of the equitable distribution and 11 12 use of funds and their economic, social, and environmental 13 impacts, and to prepare such reports that the Comptroller General determines appropriate. 14

15SEC. 80007. FUNDING FOR THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT16AND BUDGET FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF

17 **JUSTICE40.**

18 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is 19 appropriated to the Office of Management and Budget for fiscal year 2022, out of any money in the Treasury not 20 21 otherwise appropriated, \$4,000,000 to remain available 22 until September 30, 2026, for additional personnel and 23 data management expenses to support implementation of 24 the Justice 40 Initiative set forth in section 223 of Executive Order No. 14008, "Executive Order on Tackling the 25

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Climate Crisis at Home and Abroad" (January 27, 2021),
 including providing assistance to other agencies in the de velopment and implementation of methodologies to meas ure benefits, the development of a database to track agen cy benefits to disadvantaged communities, and a public facing scorecard detailing agency environmental justice
 performance measures.

8 SEC. 80008. DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA CLEAN VEHICLE 9 FLEET.

10 In addition to amounts otherwise available, there is 11 appropriated to the District of Columbia for fiscal year 12 2022, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, \$10,000,000, to remain available until ex-13 pended, for the procurement of electric vehicles and re-14 15 lated infrastructure for the District of Columbia and the management and acquisition of such electric vehicles and 16 17 infrastructure.
