

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE  
TO H.R. 1756  
OFFERED BY MRS. CAROLYN B. MALONEY OF  
NEW YORK**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Measuring Real In-  
3 come Growth Act of 2022”.

**4 SEC. 2. DISAGGREGATION OF ECONOMIC GROWTH DATA BY  
5 INCOME GROUPS.**

6 (a) INCLUSION IN REPORT.—Beginning one year  
7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Bureau  
8 shall, in each report released to the public after such date  
9 that contains a gross domestic product analysis, include  
10 economic growth data disaggregated by specific percentile  
11 groups of income, including data disaggregated—

12 (1) by each decile of income; and

13 (2) with respect to the highest 1 percent of in-  
14 come.

15 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
16 are authorized to be appropriated \$2,500,000 for each of

1 fiscal years 2023 and 2024 for the purpose of carrying  
2 out this Act.

3 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

4 (1) BUREAU.—The term “Bureau” means the  
5 Secretary of Commerce, acting through the Director  
6 of the Bureau of Economic Analysis.

7 (2) ECONOMIC GROWTH DATA.—The term “eco-  
8 nomic growth data” means the most recent data  
9 available for the amount added to the economy of  
10 the United States, including data available from—

11 (A) such gross domestic product analysis;

12 or

13 (B) an analysis of economic status of  
14 households of the United States at different in-  
15 come levels as the Bureau determines appro-  
16 priate.

17 (3) GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT ANALYSIS.—  
18 The term “gross domestic product analysis” means  
19 an analysis conducted by the Bureau with respect to  
20 the gross domestic product of the United States.
