Re: Hearing titled “Oversight of the U.S. Department of Energy”

On **Thursday, May 23, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. ET in 2154 Rayburn House Office Building**, the Committee on Oversight and Accountability will host a hearing titled “Oversight of the U.S. Department of Energy.”

I. BACKGROUND:

In the 118th Congress, the Committee on Oversight and Accountability has conducted robust oversight over the Biden Administration’s energy policies and the impact those policies have on the energy sector and national security. The Department of Energy is at the forefront of implementing the Biden Administration’s policies, especially with respect to liquified natural gas exports, electric vehicles and critical mineral supply chains, the Strategic Petroleum Reserve, and energy efficiency standards for household appliances, among other topics.

The hearing will enable members to conduct oversight and gather information from Department of Energy Secretary Jennifer Granholm on the Department’s implementation of the Biden Administration’s energy policies.
