13 “Government” before “Reform”;

14 (B) in paragraph (4), by striking “section
15 11 of the Inspector General Act of 1978 (5
16 U.S.C. App.)” and inserting “section 424 of
17 title 5, United States Code”; and

18 (C) in paragraph (5), by striking “Pan-
19 demic Response Accountability Committee” and
20 inserting “Fraud Prevention and Accountability
21 Committee”; and

22 (4) in subsection (e)(3)—

23 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “sec-
24 tion 6 of the Inspector General Act of 1978 (5

1 U.S.C. App)” and inserting “section 406 of
2 title 5, United States Code”;

3 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “sec-
4 tion 4(b)(1) of the Inspector General Act of
5 1978 (5 U.S.C. App.)” inserting “section
6 404(b)(1) of title 5, United States Code”.

7 (c) REFERENCES.—Any reference to the Pandemic
8 Response Accountability Committee in any other Federal
9 law, Executive order, rule, regulation, or delegation of au-
10 thority, or any document of or pertaining to the Pandemic
11 Response Accountability Committee, shall be deemed to
12 refer to the Fraud Prevention and Accountability Com-
13 mittee.
