To prohibit camping on public property in the District of Columbia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON CAMPING ON PUBLIC PROP-
- 4 ERTY IN DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Beginning on and after the date
- 6 of the enactment of this Act, it shall be unlawful in the
- 7 District of Columbia to camp outdoors on public property.
- 8 (b) Penalty.—Any person who violates subsection
- 9 (a) shall be fined not more than \$500, imprisoned for not
- 10 more than 30 days, or both.

- 1 (c) Camp Defined.—In this section, the term
- 2 "camp" means to use any material to set up, maintain,
- 3 or establish a temporary place of abode.
