Re: Hearing on “Examining the Public Health Risks of Carcinogens in Consumer Products”

On Tuesday, March 12, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., in room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee will hold a hearing assessing health risks to consumers related to products containing talc, such as Johnson & Johnson’s baby powder.
