In summary,

- Prior to the government shutdown, Leidos anticipated impacts to 70 contracts with civiliar
- During the shutdown, 22 programs experienced furloughs
- This resulted in 893 employees being furloughed at some point during the shutdown
- Estimated impact to daily revenue was \$400K (\$14M over 35 days) and delayed customer
- These 22 programs include approximately 200 subcontractors, of which 50% are small bus
