On Monday, February 14, 2022, at 11:00 a.m. ET, the Subcommittee on Government Operations will host a hybrid field hearing on “Waiting on the Mail: Postal Service Standard Drops in Baltimore and the Surrounding Area.” The hearing will convene in person at the University of Baltimore’s John and Frances Angelos Law Center, Baetjer Howard Moot Courtroom, 1401 North Charles Street, Baltimore, MD 21201 and over Zoom, which has been approved by the House.

Per the Office of the Attending Physician’s (OAP) guidelines, and in consultation with the Architect of the Capitol, the Chief Administrative Officer, the Sergeant at Arms, and the Committee on House Administration, the hearing room has been reconfigured to provide for

social distancing. As a result, seating in the hearing room is extremely limited and may not be able to accommodate all Members at one time.

In light of current guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and OAP, all Members and staff must wear properly fitted, medical-grade, filtration face masks (KN95 or N95 masks) masks at all times, regardless of vaccination status. Members may remove their masks only when recognized by the Chair to speak.

Members joining remotely are asked to connect by 10:30 a.m. ET to ensure their participation and troubleshoot any connectivity issues. Only Members, witnesses and their counsel, and approved Committee staff are allowed on the Zoom platform. All other staff may watch via livestream on the Committee's [website](#).
