Re: Subcommittee on Environment Hearing on "The Devil They Knew: PFAS

Contamination and the Need for Corporate Accountability, Part II."

On <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 10</u>, <u>2019</u>, <u>at 2:00 p.m.</u>, <u>in Room 2154 of the Rayburn House</u> <u>Office Building</u>, the Subcommittee will hold its third hearing on the widespread contamination of drinking water, ground water, air and food supplies with per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

This hearing, which will focus on PFAS contamination by industrial producers, serves as a follow-up to the Subcommittee's July 24, 2019, hearing on the human impact of PFAS contamination and state-level efforts to regulate the chemicals.

#### I. HEARING PURPOSE

The hearing will examine the health risks associated with PFAS chemicals; what chemical manufacturers knew about this science and when they knew it; the current levels of PFAS contamination in the United States; and industry efforts to clean up contaminated sites.
