Bio: Donald Sherman serves as Senior Vice President and Chief Counsel for Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington (CREW), having returned to the group from the White House. He is a leading policy advisor on racial justice and equity, government ethics, congressional investigations and oversight. He has served in various roles in the House, Senate, and the Executive Branch, including as Special Assistant to the President for Racial and Economic Justice at the White House, Senior Counsel to Ranking Member Claire McCaskill on the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee, and Chief Oversight Counsel to the late Rep. Elijah Cummings, then-Ranking Member of the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform. Donald began his career on Capitol Hill as counsel on the House Ethics Committee where he investigated alleged ethical violations by Members of Congress and staff. Prior to that, Donald practiced law in Washington, D.C., for Crowell & Moring, LLP and served as a law clerk to the Honorable Neil E. Kravitz of the District of Columbia Superior Court. He graduated *cum laude* from Georgetown University with a degree in American Studies and earned his J.D. from the Georgetown University Law Center.
