



Prairie Rose Seminole, Community Organizer

Prairie Rose Seminole is an enrolled tribal member of the Three Affiliated Tribes of North Dakota, descendant of the Sahnish/Arikara, Northern Cheyenne, Mandan and Lakota Nations. She has worked as a community organizer for over 10 years. Prairie Rose works around the country with the Native American Leadership Program, with Wellstone Action to train and empower leaders, activists, campaign workers, and those seeking elected office. Most recently she worked as North Dakota's Native Vote director during the 2018 election, travelling from reservation to reservation dealing with issues as they arose, knocking on doors turning out the vote, and ensuring tribes had the resources needed to get as many IDs into the hands of voters as possible. Prairie Rose has served as a District 45 delegate to the North Dakota Democratic Convention since 2008 and as the Native American liaison to the DEM-NPL Executive Committee. In 2010 she ran for State Representative in North Dakota's 45th legislative district.
