

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3586
OFFERED BY MS. LORETTA SANCHEZ OF
CALIFORNIA**

Page 19, beginning line 17, insert the following (and redesignate subsequent sections accordingly and make necessary technical and conforming changes):

1 **SEC. 4. STRATEGIC PERSONNEL PLAN FOR U.S. CUSTOMS**
2 **AND BORDER PROTECTION PERSONNEL DE-**
3 **PLOYED ABROAD.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 270 days of after
5 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Commissioner
6 of U.S. Customs and Border Protection shall provide to
7 the Committee on Homeland Security of the House of
8 Representatives and the Committee on Homeland Security
9 and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a three year stra-
10 tegic plan for deployment of U.S. Customs and Border
11 Protection (in this section referred to as “CBP”) per-
12 sonnel to locations outside the United States.

13 (b) CONTENTS.—The plan required under subsection
14 (a) shall include the following:

1 (1) A risk-based method for determining expansion
2 of CBP international programs to new locations,
3 given resource constraints.

4 (2) A plan to ensure CBP personnel deployed at
5 locations outside the United States have appropriate
6 oversight and support to ensure performance in support
7 of program goals.

8 (3) Information on planned future deployments
9 of CBP personnel for a three year period, together
10 with corresponding information on locations for such
11 deployments outside the United States.

12 (c) CONSIDERATIONS.—In preparing the plan required
13 under subsection (a), the Commissioner of U.S.
14 Customs and Border Protection shall consider, and include
15 information on, the following:

16 (1) Existing CBP programs in operation outside
17 of the United States, together with specific information
18 on locations outside the United States in which each
19 such program operates.

20 (2) The number of CBP personnel deployed at
21 each location outside the United States during the
22 preceding fiscal year.
