Daniel Flesch Biography

Daniel Flesch is a Senior Policy Analyst for Middle East and North Africa in the Allison Center for National Security at the Heritage Foundation. He also manages the Heritage Foundation's National Task Force to Combat Antisemitism and the implementation of Project Esther: a National Strategy to Combat Antisemitism.

From 2018-2021, Flesch served as Senior Advisor to Israel's Permanent Mission to the United Nations. He was the Founder and Executive Director of Fuel for Truth—D.C., an Israel education and advocacy program. Flesch also served in the 202nd Paratrooper Battalion of the Israel Defense Forces, where he was twice recognized as Outstanding Platoon Soldier. He wrote about his experiences and why Americans serve in the IDF for Commentary Magazine.

His perspective on antisemitism, Israel, the Middle East and defense issues has been featured in CBN, CNBC, CNN, Fox News, NewsNation, Newsmax, Times of Israel and other outlets, and he has briefed Congressional leaders and staff and policy organizations.

He received his master's degree in international relations and international economics from the Johns Hopkins School of Advanced International Studies, and his bachelor's degree in political science and history from the University of Illinois.
