David Borer is the General Counsel for the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO. AFGE represents over 600,000 members, primarily in the federal and D.C. government. As General Counsel he directs a staff of approximately 25 attorneys engaged in all aspects of employment and labor law, including an extensive practice before the MSPB, the FLRA, various other agencies and in arbitration, as well as in the federal courts. He also serves as a top policy advisor to the union's leadership.

Before joining AFGE in 2010, David was the Executive Director/Treasurer of the Massachusetts Teachers Association where he oversaw the staff and operations of the largest union in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. His earlier career in the Labor Movement includes over 22 years with the Association of Flight Attendants – CWA, AFL-CIO. In over two decades as AFA's General Counsel he directed the union's negotiations for hundreds of major collective bargaining agreements, and oversaw the union's arbitration and litigation practice.
