

**AMENDMENT TO THE COMMITTEE PRINT OF THE
TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRA-
TION REFORM AND IMPROVEMENT ACT OF
2015**

Amend section 203 to read as follows:

1 **SEC. 203. SECURITY TRAINING FOR FRONTLINE TRANSPOR-**
2 **TATION WORKERS.**

3 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
4 ment of the Act, the Administrator shall submit to the
5 Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Rep-
6 resentatives and the Committee on Homeland Security
7 and Governmental Affairs and the Committee on Com-
8 merce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a report
9 regarding the status of the implementation of sections
10 1408 (6 U.S.C. 1137) and 1534 (6 U.S.C. 1184) of the
11 Implementing Recommendations of the 9/11 Commission
12 Act of 2007 (Public Law 110–53). The Administrator
13 shall include in such report specific information on the
14 challenges that the Administrator has encountered since
15 the date of the enactment of the Implementing Rec-
16 ommendations of the 9/11 Commission Act of 2007 with
17 respect to establishing regulations requiring the provision

- 1 of basic security training to public transportation frontline
- 2 employees and over-the-road bus frontline employees for
- 3 preparedness for potential security threats and conditions.
