Clyde D. Miller, BASF Corporation's Director of Corporate Security since 2004, is responsible for critical security initiatives, both at the corporate level and at BASF production sites across North America. These responsibilities include development, implementation and execution of BASF's Crisis Management and response plan, ensuring compliance with and implementation of the federal Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards, in addition to overseeing other company-wide initiatives such as BASF Corporation's Workplace Violence Prevention Program.

In addition, Mr. Miller has served as Chair of the Chemical Sector Coordinating Council, Chair of the Partnership for Critical Infrastructure Protection, established by the National Infrastructure Protection Plan to serve as the cross-sector coordinating council interface with the Department of Homeland Security, and is currently the non-federal Vice Chair of the State, Local, Tribal, and Private Sector Policy Advisory Committee, created under Presidential Executive Order 13549. He recently served on the Homeland Security Studies and Analysis Institute's CFATS Tiering Methodology Peer Review Panel.

Prior to joining BASF, he served as Director of Corporate Security and Safety for Gateway, Inc., in San Diego, CA. and held senior security executive positions at Texas Instruments, Inc., in Dallas, TX. and Halliburton/Brown & Root, Inc., in Houston, TX.

Mr. Miller earned his MBA at Southern Methodist University, Dallas, TX.
