

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 4007
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY**

Page 3, starting on line 12, strike paragraph (1)
and insert the following:

- 1 (1) AUDITS AND INSPECTIONS.—
- 2 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall ar-
- 3 range for the audit and inspection of covered
- 4 chemical facilities for the purpose of deter-
- 5 mining compliance with this Act. Under any
- 6 such arrangement, the audit and inspection
- 7 may be carried out by a non-Department or
- 8 nongovernment entity, as approved by the Sec-
- 9 retary.
- 10 (B) REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-GOVERN-
- 11 MENT PERSONNEL.—If the Secretary arranges
- 12 for an audit or inspection under subparagraph
- 13 (A) to be carried out by a non-Department or
- 14 nongovernment entity, the Secretary shall re-
- 15 quire, as a condition of such arrangement, that
- 16 any individual who conducts the audit or in-
- 17 spection meet the following requirements:

1 (i) The individual is a citizen of the
2 United States.

3 (ii) The individual submits a financial
4 disclosure statement.

5 (iii) The individual maintains a secret
6 security clearance.

7 (iv) The individual consents to being
8 medically monitored.

9 (v) The individual has attended chem-
10 ical security training

11 (vi) The individual has completed one
12 of the following:

13 (I) One full year of specialized
14 experience that involved knowledge of
15 homeland security, infrastructure pro-
16 tection, information security, intel-
17 ligence and law enforcement informa-
18 tion, and information analysis, along
19 with knowledge of analytical and in-
20 vestigative techniques, including—

21 (aa) the performance of in-
22 spections to determine if viola-
23 tions have occurred;

24 (bb) the conduct of inves-
25 tigations using accepted inspec-

1 tion, investigation, enforcement,
2 or compliance principles, con-
3 cepts, and methodologies and
4 problem solving techniques; or

5 (cc) preparing reports for
6 both the private and public sec-
7 tor.

8 (II) A Master's degree or two full
9 years of progressively higher-level
10 graduate education (36 semester units
11 or the number of units your school
12 uses to describe two graduate years of
13 academic study) from an accredited
14 college or university in a program that
15 provided the knowledge, skills and
16 abilities to conduct audits or inspec-
17 tions under subparagraph (A).

18 (III) A combination of the edu-
19 cation and specialized experience de-
20 scribed in subclauses (I) and (II).
