## A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT-TERM LIMITED DURATION INSURANCE**

4 **RULE PROHIBITION.**

5 The Secretary of Health and Human Services, the  
6 Secretary of the Treasury, and the Secretary of Labor  
7 may not take any action to implement, enforce, or other-  
8 wise give effect to the rule entitled “Short-Term, Limited

1 Duration Insurance” (83 Fed. Reg. 38212 (August 3,  
2 2018)), and the Secretaries may not promulgate any sub-  
3 stantially similar rule.
