# H. R. 2088

To amend the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 to reauthorize the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program, and for other purposes.

Mr. STANTON (for himself and Mr. VEASEY) introduced the following bill;  
which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

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## A BILL

To amend the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 to reauthorize the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION**  
4 **BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.**

5 (a) PURPOSE.—Section 542(b)(1) of the Energy  
6 Independence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C.  
7 17152(b)(1)) is amended—

1           (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “; and”  
2           and inserting a semicolon;

3           (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking the semi-  
4           colon and inserting “; and”; and

5           (3) by adding at the end the following:

6                   “(C) diversifies energy supplies, including  
7                   by facilitating and promoting the use of alter-  
8                   native fuels;”.

9           (b) USE OF FUNDS.—Section 544(9) of the Energy  
10          Independence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C.  
11          17154(9)) is amended to read as follows:

12                   “(9) deployment of energy distribution tech-  
13                   nologies that significantly increase energy efficiency  
14                   or expand access to alternative fuels, including—

15                           “(A) distributed resources;

16                           “(B) district heating and cooling systems;

17                           and

18                           “(C) infrastructure for delivering alter-  
19                           native fuels;”.

20           (c) COMPETITIVE GRANTS.—Section 546(c)(2) of the  
21          Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (42  
22          U.S.C. 17156(c)(2)) is amended by inserting “, including  
23          projects to expand the use of alternative fuels” before the  
24          period at the end.

1 (d) FUNDING.—Section 548(a) of the Energy Inde-  
2 pendence and Security Act of 2007 (42 U.S.C. 17158(a))  
3 is amended to read as follows:

4 “(a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

5 “(1) GRANTS.—There is authorized to be ap-  
6 propriated to the Secretary to carry out the program  
7 \$3,500,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020  
8 through 2024.

9 “(2) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.—The Secretary  
10 may use for administrative expenses of the program  
11 not more than 1 percent of the amounts made avail-  
12 able under paragraph (1) in each of fiscal years  
13 2020 through 2024.”.

14 (e) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—Section 543 of the  
15 Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (42  
16 U.S.C. 17153) is amended—

17 (1) in subsection (c), by striking “subsection  
18 (a)(2)” and inserting “subsection (a)(3)”; and

19 (2) in subsection (d), by striking “subsection  
20 (a)(3)” and inserting “subsection (a)(4)”.
