- 15 purposes of section 1886(h) of the Social Security Act (42)
- 16 U.S.C. 1395ww(h))) in order to encourage such hospitals
- 17 to establish such a program.
- 18 (b) Critical Access Hospital Grant Pro-
- 19 GRAM.—Not later than 1 year after the date of the enact-

- 1 ment of this Act, the Secretary shall establish a grant pro-
- 2 gram under which the Secretary awards grants to critical
- 3 access hospitals (as defined in section 1861 of the Social
- 4 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x)) that do not have in effect
- 5 an affiliation agreement with a hospital with an approved
- 6 medical residency training program to host residents of
- 7 such program in order to assist such critical access hos-
- 8 pitals in setting up such affiliations in order to host such
- 9 residents.
- 10 (c) Report.—Not later than 10 years after the date
- 11 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of
- 12 the United States shall submit to Congress a report con-
- 13 taining an analysis of the number of residents who trained
- 14 at a hospital or critical access hospital that received a
- 15 grant under subsection (a) or (b).
