Add at the end the following:

1	SEC PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT IMPROVEMENT.
2	(a) In General.—Not later than 90 days after the
3	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Trans-
4	portation shall convene a working group to consider better
5	practices for engaging the public on pipeline safety.
6	(b) Membership.—The working group convened
7	pursuant to subsection (a) shall include balanced represen-
8	tation from—
9	(1) Federal, Tribal, State, and local officials re-
10	sponsible for pipeline safety oversight;
11	(2) liquids and natural gas transmission and
12	distribution pipeline operating companies and sys-
13	tems; and
14	(3) public, safety, environmental, and labor ad-
15	vocates and representatives.
16	(c) Considerations.—The working group convened
17	pursuant to subsection (a) shall consider and provide rec-
18	ommendations to the Secretary on—

1	(1) the scope of engagement between individ-
2	uals, groups, companies, agencies, and the public at
3	large;
4	(2) better practices for communication of poten-
5	tial or proposed pipeline projects;
6	(3) better practices for communication for exist-
7	ing pipelines;
8	(4) better practices for communication of pipe-
9	line risk and hazards;
10	(5) better practices for communication of pipe-
11	line safety requirements and pipeline safety activi-
12	ties; and
13	(6) better engagement around emergency re-
14	sponse for pipelines.
15	(d) Publication.—Not later than 1 year after the
16	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall publish
17	the consensus recommendations of the working group.
18	SEC USE OF A FIREARM TO DAMAGE PIPELINE INFRA-
19	STRUCTURE UNDER CONSTRUCTION.
20	Section 60123 of title 49, United States Code, is
21	amended by adding at the end the following:
22	"(e) Penalty for Using a Firearm to Damage
23	PIPELINE INFRASTRUCTURE UNDER CONSTRUCTION.—
24	"(1) Penalty.—A person who knowingly and
25	willfully uses a firearm to puncture a pipe, pump, or

1	valve intended to be used in a facility described in
2	subsection (b) shall be fined under title 18, impris-
3	oned for not more than 5 years, or both.
4	"(2) Rule of Construction.—Nothing in
5	this subsection abridges the exercise of rights guar-
6	anteed under the First Amendment to the Constitu-
7	tion of the United States.".
