A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize certain poison control programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Poison Control Centers
5 Reauthorization Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF POISON CONTROL PRO-**
2 **GRAMS.**

3 (a) NATIONAL TOLL-FREE NUMBER AND OTHER
4 COMMUNICATION CAPABILITIES.—Section 1271(c) of the
5 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300d–71(c)) is
6 amended by striking “fiscal years 2020 through 2024”
7 and inserting “fiscal years 2025 through 2029”.

8 (b) PROMOTING POISON CONTROL CENTER UTILIZA-
9 TION.—Section 1272(c) of the Public Health Service Act
10 (42 U.S.C. 300d–72(c)) is amended by striking “fiscal
11 years 2020 through 2024” and inserting “fiscal years
12 2025 through 2029”.

13 (c) POISON CONTROL CENTER GRANT PROGRAM.—
14 Section 1273(g) of the Public Health Service Act (42
15 U.S.C. 300d–73(g)) is amended by striking “fiscal years
16 2020 through 2024” and inserting “fiscal years 2025
17 through 2029”.
