The Subcommittee on Energy met, pursuant to notice, at 10 a.m., in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, Hon. Bobby L. Rush (Chairman of the subcommittee) presiding. The business before the subcommittee was consideration and markup of 9 energy bills referred to the subcommittee. The following actions were taken:

- (1) **H.R. 2906**, the “**Clean Commute for Kids Act of 2019**” (*Cárdenas of CA*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (2) **H.R. 3361**, the “**Reliable Investment in Vital Energy Reauthorization Act**” or the “**RIVER Act**” (*McKinley, Tonko, Loeb sack, Watkins, and Tipton*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (3) **H.R. 3079**, the “**Energy Savings Through Public-Private Partnerships Act of 2019**” (*Welch of VT and Kinzinger of IL*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (4) **H.R. 5518**, a bill to require the Secretary of Energy to establish a grant program for States to provide incentives to natural gas distribution systems (*McEachin of IL*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (5) **H.R. 5542**, a bill to require the Secretary of Energy to establish a grant program for States to provide incentives to natural gas distribution systems (*Sherrill and Blunt Rochester*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (6) **H.R. 5541**, the “**Tribal Power Act**” (*O’Halleran and Mullin*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (7) **H.R. 5527**, the “**21st Century Power Grid Act**”; (*Sarbanes, McNerney, Kennedy, and Veasey*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (8) **H.R. 1426**, the “**Timely Review of Infrastructure Act**” (*Olson, Doyle, Thompson of MS, and Weber of TX*), was favorably forwarded to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.
- (9) **H.R. 5545**, the “**New Opportunities to Expand Healthy Air Using Sustainable Transportation Act of 2020**” or the “**NO EXHAUST Act of 2020**” (*Rush of IL*), was **favorably forwarded** to the full Committee, without amendment, by a voice vote.

The business before the Subcommittee having been completed, Chairman Rush adjourned the meeting at 11:56 a.m., subject to the call of the chair.
