

Dr. Timothy Davis has been building and expanding patient focused pharmacy practices for over a decade. His experience ranges from the design and construction of clean rooms, compounding laboratories, community pharmacies, pharmacy management software, and adherence technology.

Dr. Davis received his Doctor of Pharmacy degree from the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy following a Bachelors of Science in Neuroscience from the same University. He began his educational career in a biomedical engineering program at Carnegie Mellon University.

He guest lectures at the University of Pittsburgh on pharmacoeconomics, pharmacy business design, and patient focused care systems. He has held numerous national positions including Chairman of the McKesson Independent Advisory Board, Chairman of the National Community Pharmacists Association Committee for Technology and Innovation, Board of Directors American Society for Automation in Pharmacy, Chairman of the Pitt School of Pharmacy Alumni Association, and the Health Mart Marketing Advisory Board. Dr. Davis has just finished serving on the eHIT Collaborative Workgroup helping to design the roadmap for inclusion of pharmacy practice in the nation's electronic health strategy. In 2012, he served on the White House PDMP Workgroup gathered to implement a national design for tracking and sharing of controlled substance prescription drug data. This same year, he testified before a Congressional panel designated to explore Track and Trace within the pharmacy supply chain. His testimony focused on the current supply chain security measures and the technology impact on independent pharmacy practices. He continues to speak at most national conferences as a regular personality.

Dr. Davis owns 2 independent community pharmacies, Beaver Health Mart Pharmacy and Beaver Falls Health Mart Pharmacy. Although he spends his days practicing with his father at the Brighton Health Mart Pharmacy, he also launched the nationally recognized PANTHERx Specialty Pharmacy in 2011. Focusing on technology solutions to advance the Specialty At Retail initiatives in community pharmacy, PANTHERx has grown into not only a distribution partner for health plans and employers, but also a community pharmacy friendly solution to enable patient care solution surrounding specialty pharmacy to remain local. His most recent business venture has been RevolutionRx. Designed as a consulting firm advising on technology and policy, RevolutionRx brings the voice and expertise of highly visible community pharmacy owners and pharmacists to technology vendors and governing bodies. The current client list includes automation vendors, drug manufacturers, wholesalers, and franchises.
