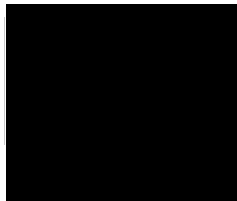

Allan Coukell BSc(Pharm) – Senior Director, Health Programs, The Pew Charitable Trusts

Allan directs health work at The Pew Charitable Trusts, a nonprofit research and policy organization, overseeing initiatives related to drug innovation and safety, pharmaceutical supply chain, pharmacy compounding, specialty drug costs, substance abuse, antimicrobial resistance, medical devices, food safety, school nutrition, health impact assessment and improving care at the end of life. Prior to joining Pew, he practiced as a clinical pharmacist in oncology at the Victoria Hospital in London, Ontario, and served as a senior medical writer and editor with the journal publisher Adis International. He also worked as a health and science reporter for WBUR, Boston's National Public Radio news station, and at Radio New Zealand. He is vice chair of the Medical Device Innovation Consortium and serves on the board of the Reagan Udall Foundation for the Food and Drug Administration. He is a graduate of the University of Manitoba and completed his hospital pharmacy residency at the Winnipeg Health Sciences Centre.
