

Jamie Ryan Daniels was the first born son of Lisa Daniels and Ken Daniels, and big brother to his sister, Arlyn.

Jamie was born in Toronto, Canada May 6th, 1993. In February 1998, Jamie, Arlyn and Lisa moved to West Bloomfield, Michigan, where they joined Ken who had been hired by the Detroit Red Wings Hockey Club.

In 2009, Jamie, along with his mother and sister, became an American citizen.

Jamie attended public elementary school in West Bloomfield, before being invited after grade 2, into a special program for gifted children for the remaining 3 years of elementary school. He attended a public middle school and a private high school, before being accepted to Michigan State University.

At 12 years old, Jamie began volunteering at The Friendship Circle of Michigan, a non-profit organization which provides support and companionship to individuals with special needs. He continued to volunteer there during his high school years.

Jamie was an avid sportsman. In addition to hockey and soccer, he played tennis and skied. Eventually, his love of hockey prevailed, and he played both ice and roller hockey, taking home many team awards. His deep commitment to hockey led him to create his own hockey clothing line called 'Dangle Dangle Snipe', a business which he ran while in high school.

In 2011 Jamie went off to Michigan State University. He joined Greek life and was accepted into the fraternity he wanted. Eventually, he began working with the Michigan State Hockey Club as the team video coordinator. He interned for an attorney in East Lansing before graduating with a degree in Communications, earning a 3.5 GPA.

After graduating in 2015, he intended on going on to law school. He continued working as a law clerk while studying for the LSAT. His goal was to become a sports agent.
