## A BILL

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Responsible Education
5 Achieves Care and Healthy Outcomes for Users' Treat6 ment Act of 2018" or the "REACH OUT Act of 2018".

## 1 SEC. 2. GRANTS TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO 2 OUTLIER PRESCRIBERS OF OPIOIDS.

3 (a) GRANTS AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of Health
4 and Human Services (in this section referred to as the
5 "Secretary") shall, through the Centers for Medicare &
6 Medicaid Services, award grants, contracts, or cooperative
7 agreements to eligible entities for the purposes described
8 in subsection (b).

9 (b) USE OF FUNDS.—Grants, contracts, and coopera-10 tive agreements awarded under subsection (a) shall be 11 used to support eligible entities through technical assist-12 ance—

(1) to educate and provide outreach to outlier
prescribers of opioids about best practices for prescribing opioids;

16 (2) to educate and provide outreach to outlier
17 prescribers of opioids about non-opioid pain manage18 ment therapies; and

19 (3) to reduce the amount of opioid prescriptions20 prescribed by outlier prescribers of opioids.

(c) APPLICATION.—Each eligible entity seeking to receive a grant, contract, or cooperative agreement under
subsection (a) shall submit to the Secretary an application, at such time, in such manner, and containing such
information as the Secretary may require.

1 scriber, identified by the Secretary of Health and 2 Human Services (through use of prescriber informa-3 tion provided by prescriber National Provider Identi-4 fiers included pursuant to section 1860D-4(c)(4)(A)5 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w-6 104(c)(4)(A)) on claims for covered part D drugs for 7 part D eligible individuals enrolled in prescription 8 drug plans under part D of title XVIII of such Act 9 (42 U.S.C. 1395w–101 et seq.) and MA–PD plans 10 under part C of such title (42 U.S.C. 1395w-21 et 11 seq.)) as prescribing, as compared to other pre-12 scribers in the specialty of the prescriber and geo-13 graphic area, amounts of opioids in excess of a 14 threshold (and other criteria) specified by the Sec-15 retary, after consultation with stakeholders.

16 (3) PRESCRIBERS.—The term "prescriber"
17 means any health care professional, including a
18 nurse practitioner or physician assistant, who is li19 censed to prescribe opioids by the State or territory
20 in which such professional practices.

(f) FUNDING.—For purposes of implementing this
section, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall
provide for the transfer from the Federal Supplementary
Medical Insurance Trust Fund established under section
1841 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395t) to the
