

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2781**

**OFFERED BY MR. BURGESS OF TEXAS**

Page 2, line 25, strike “\$14,899,000” and insert “\$20,000,000”.

Page 11, line 22, through page 13, line 2, strike subparagraph (B) (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary).

Page 16, lines 6 and 7, strike “to spend 75 percent of the total time of such individual” and insert “to spend 75 percent of the individual’s time that is supported by the award”.

Page 19, line 12, insert “child and adolescent psychiatry subspecialty,” before “or child and adolescent mental and behavioral health residency or fellowship”.

Page 19, line 16, insert “child and adolescent psychiatry subspecialty care,” before “or child and adolescent mental and behavioral health care, including substance use disorder prevention and treatment services”.

Page 19, line 23, insert “the child and adolescent psychiatry subspecialty,” before “or child and adolescent mental and behavioral health”.

Page 20, line 3, insert “the child and adolescent psychiatry subspecialty,” before “or child and adolescent mental and behavioral health”.

Page 21, lines 4 and 5, amend the heading of paragraph (2) to read as follows: “CHILD AND ADOLESCENT PSYCHIATRY AND MENTAL AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH”.

Strike page 21, lines 10 through 23, amend subparagraphs (A) and (B) to read as follows:

1           “(A) has received specialized training or  
2           clinical experience in child and adolescent men-  
3           tal health in psychiatry, psychology, school psy-  
4           chology, or psychiatric nursing;

5           “(B) has a license or certification in a  
6           State to practice allopathic medicine, osteo-  
7           pathic medicine, psychology, school psychology,  
8           or psychiatric nursing; or”

Page 22, line 4, strike “clause (i)” and insert “sub-paragraph (A)”.

Page 22, lines 13 through 15, amend subparagraph (B) to read as follows:

9           “(B) the professional is a United States  
10           citizen, a permanent legal United States resi-

1           dent, or lawfully present in the United States;  
2           and”.

Page 23, lines 1 through 3, strike paragraph (1)  
(and make such conforming changes as may be necessary).
