Subcommittee on Health

The Subcommittee on Health met, pursuant to notice, in **open markup session** on Wednesday, November 13, 2019, at 10 a.m. in the John D. Dingell Room, 2123 of the Rayburn House Office Building, Ms. Eshoo, *the chairwoman*, presiding. The markup session convened at 10:08 a.m. to consider four public health improvement bills. The following action was taken:

H.R. 2339, the “**Reversing the Youth Tobacco Epidemic Act of 2019**”, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote. The following amendments were offered during consideration of H.R. 2339:

An amendment in the nature of a substitute (AINS) by Mr. Pallone, # 1, was agreed to by a voice vote, amended. Previously, the following amendments were offered to the Pallone AINS, # 1:

An amendment offered by Mr. Burgess, # 1A, was defeated by a roll call vote of 12 yeas to 17 nays (HE-roll call no. 8);

An amendment offered by Mr. Butterfield, # 1B, was agreed to by a voice vote;

An amendment offered by Mr. Walden, # 1C, was defeated by a voice vote;

An amendment offered by Ms. Castor, # 1D, was withdrawn; and

An amendment offered by Mr. Burgess, # 1E, was agreed to by a voice vote.

H.R. 4995, the “**Maternal Health Quality Improvement Act of 2019**”, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, as introduced, by a voice vote.

No amendments were offered to the bill.

H.R. 4996, the “**Helping Medicaid Offer Maternity Services (MOMS) Act of 2019**”, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee, amended, by a voice vote. The following amendment was offered to the bill:

An amendment offered by Mr. Burgess, # 1, was agreed to by a voice vote.

H.R. 2387, the “**Stop The Overuse of Petitions and Get Affordable Medicines to Enter Soon Act of 2019**” or the “**STOP GAMES Act of 2019**”, was forwarded favorably to the full Committee by a voice vote, as introduced.

No amendments were offered to the bill.

Whereupon, there being no further business, the Subcommittee adjourned at 1:13 p.m., subject to the call of the chair.
