**SUBJECT: Subcommittee Hearing on “Booster Shot: Enhancing Public Health through Vaccine Legislation”**

The Subcommittee on Health of the Committee on Energy and Commerce will hold a virtual, fully remote hearing on **Tuesday June 15, 2021, at 10:30 a.m. (EDT)**. The hearing is entitled, “Booster Shot: Enhancing Public Health through Vaccine Legislation.” Witnesses will be by invitation only.
