16 amended by striking “10 year”.

17 **SEC. 3. COORDINATION OF NIH FUNDING FOR PEDIATRIC**
18 **RESEARCH.**

19 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the Con-
20 gress that the Director of the National Institutes of
21 Health should continue to oversee and coordinate research
22 that is conducted or supported by the National Institutes
23 of Health for research on pediatric cancer and other pedi-
24 atric diseases and conditions, including through the Pedi-
25 atric Research Initiative Fund.

1 (b) AVOIDING DUPLICATION.—Section
2 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act (42
3 U.S.C. 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)) is amended by inserting “and
4 shall prioritize, as appropriate, such pediatric research
5 that does not duplicate existing research activities of the
6 National Institutes of Health” before “; and”.

7 **SEC. 4. REPORT ON PROGRESS AND INVESTMENTS IN PEDI-**
8 **ATRIC RESEARCH.**

9 Not later than 5 years after the date of the enact-
10 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human
11 Services shall submit to the appropriate committees of
12 Congress a report that—

13 (1) details pediatric research projects and ini-
14 tiatives receiving funds allocated pursuant to section
15 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act
16 (42 U.S.C. 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)); and

17 (2) summarizes advancements made in pediatric
18 research with funds allocated pursuant to section
19 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act
20 (42 U.S.C. 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)).

Amend the title of the bill so as to read: “To extend the Gabriella Miller Kids First Pediatric Research Program at the National Institutes of Health, and for other purposes.”.
