6	(a) In General.—Section 1905(a)(31)(B) of the So-
7	cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(a)(31)(B)) is amended

9	vidual who is a child in foster care under the responsibility
10	of a State who has been placed, in accordance with the
11	requirements of section 475A(c), in a child care institution
12	that is a qualified residential treatment program (as de-
13	fined in section 472(k)(4)), but only if payments are being
14	made on behalf of such child under section 472 with re-
15	spect to which Federal payments may be made under sec-
16	tion 474(a)(1) and only if the child continues to be in fos-
17	ter care under the responsibility of a State" after "section

19	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
20	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to medical assist-
21	ance furnished in calendar quarters beginning on or after
22	October 1, 2023.
