12 (b) REQUIREMENTS WITH RESPECT TO TYPE AND
13 QUALITY OF SERVICES.—Section 1503 of the Public
14 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300m) is amended—

15 (1) in subsection (a)—

16 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “that,
17 initially” and all that follows through the semi-
18 colon and inserting “that appropriate breast
19 and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic
20 services are provided based on national rec-
21 ommendations; and”;

22 (B) by striking paragraphs (2) and (4);

23 (C) by redesignating paragraph (3) as
24 paragraph (2); and

1 (D) in paragraph (2), as so redesignated,
2 by striking “; and” and inserting a period; and
3 (2) by striking subsection (d).

4 (c) REPORTS TO CONGRESS.—Section 1508(b) of the
5 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300n–4(b)) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in the heading, by striking “REPORT” and
8 inserting “REPORTS”;

9 (2) by striking “1 year after the date of the en-
10 actment of the National Breast and Cervical Cancer
11 Early Detection Program Reauthorization of 2007,
12 and annually thereafter,” and inserting “2 years
13 after the date of enactment of the SCREENS for
14 Cancer Act of 2024, and every 5 years thereafter,”;

15 (3) by striking “Labor and Human Resources”
16 and inserting “Health, Education, Labor, and Pen-
17 sions”; and

18 (4) by striking “preceding fiscal year” and in-
19 serting “preceding 2 fiscal years in the case of the
20 first report after the date of enactment of the
21 SCREENS for Cancer Act of 2024, and preceding
22 5 fiscal years for each report thereafter,”.

23 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
24 1510(a) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.
25 300n–5(a)) is amended—

- 1 (1) by striking “and” after “2011,”; and
- 2 (2) by inserting “, and \$275,000,000 for each
- 3 of fiscal years 2025 through 2029” before the period
- 4 at the end.

Amend the title of the bill to read as follows: “To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize and improve the National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program for fiscal years 2025 through 2029, and for other purposes.”.
