I. INTRODUCTION

The Subcommittee on Health will hold a markup on Wednesday, September 10, 2025, at 10:15 a.m. (ET) in 2123 Rayburn House Office Building. The markup will consider the following legislation:

- H.R. 4262, To reauthorize programs related to health professions education, and for other purposes. (Rep. Schakowsky)
- H.R. 3593, Title VIII Nursing Workforce Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. D. Joyce)
- H.R. 2493, Improving Care in Rural America Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. Carter of GA)
- H.R. 3419, To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the telehealth network and telehealth resource centers grant programs. (Rep. Valadao)
- H.R. 3302, Healthy Start Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. Ocasio-Cortez)
- H.R. 2846, To amend title II of the Public Health Service Act to include as an additional right or privilege of commissioned officers of the Public Health Service (and their beneficiaries) certain leave provided under title 10, United States Code to commissioned officers of the Army (or their beneficiaries). (Rep. Houlahan)
- H.R. 4709, Newborn Screening Saves Lives Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. Morrison)

II. LEGISLATION

H.R. 4262, To reauthorize programs related to health professions education, and for other purposes. (Rep. Schakowsky)

This legislation would reauthorize programs within Title VII of the Public Health Service Act (PHSA) through Fiscal Year 2030. Title VII programs help support the health care workforce through education and training.

H.R. 3593, Title VIII Nursing Workforce Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. D. Joyce)

This legislation would reauthorize programs within Title VIII of the PHSA through Fiscal Year 2030. Title VIII programs support nursing workforce development through education and training.

H.R. 2493, Improving Care in Rural America Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. Carter of GA)

This legislation would reauthorize grant programs for rural health care services outreach, rural health network development, and small health care provider improvement through Fiscal Year 2030.

H.R. 3419, To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the telehealth network and telehealth resource centers grant programs. (Rep. Valadao)

This legislation would reauthorize the telehealth network and telehealth resource centers grant programs through Fiscal Year 2030.

H.R. 3302, Healthy Start Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. Ocasio-Cortez)

This legislation would reauthorize the Healthy Start program through Fiscal Year 2030.

H.R. 2846, To amend title II of the Public Health Service Act to include as an additional right or privilege of commissioned officers of the Public Health Service (and their beneficiaries) certain leave provided under title 10, United States Code to commissioned officers of the Army (or their beneficiaries). (Rep. Houlihan)

This legislation would amend the PHSA so that the process of acquiring leave for commissioned Public Health Service officers aligns with that of other uniformed services.

H.R. 4709, Newborn Screening Saves Lives Reauthorization Act of 2025 (Rep. Morrison)

This legislation would reauthorize certain programs and activities related to newborn screening of heritable disorders through Fiscal Year 2030.
